The challenge is to read through the whole Gospel of John between now and Christmas. This means reading one chapter a day on most days. Some of the longer chapters have been divided in two, and the Sundays have been left as catch-up days in case you fall behind.

The aim of reading the Bible is to get to know Jesus better, and to live our lives for him. To help you get the most out of reading John's Gospel, try following these steps:

**Rest** As best you can, find a place and time when you can have peace and quiet. It's best to use the same place and time every day if you can. Turn your phone off!

Pray Ask God to speak to you through today's reading. You could use a prayer like "Open my eyes that I may see wonderful things in your law" (Psalm 119:18) or "Speak, Lord, for your servant is listening" (1 Samuel 3:9).

**Read** Read the passage through, taking your time to listen to what it says. Think about these questions:

- What does this passage reveal about God the Father/Jesus/ the Holy Spirit?
- Are there any surprises in this passage?
- What does this passage teach me about being a disciple of Jesus?
- What do I need to change, pray or do as a response to what God is saying to me through this passage?

**Pray** Tell God what you have heard in this passage, and tell him how you are going to respond. You may need to confess a sin, claim a promise, or ask for help for some particular need.

Pray Tell God what you have heard in this passage, and tell him how you are going to respond. You may need to confess a sin, claim a promise, or ask for help for some particular need.
