**Thankyou:** To everyone who has worked so hard to get our in-church services up and running. A special word of thanks to our churchwardens and vestry members for all their support and advice.

Reopening for in-church worship: A separate letter has gone out with full details of this. The key messages are: 1. DO NOT come to church if you have COVID symptoms (fever, cough, breathing difficulties). 2. Maintain social distancing of 2m. 3. Sanitise hands on entry and exit.
