of peace for evermore;**




**till with the vision glorious

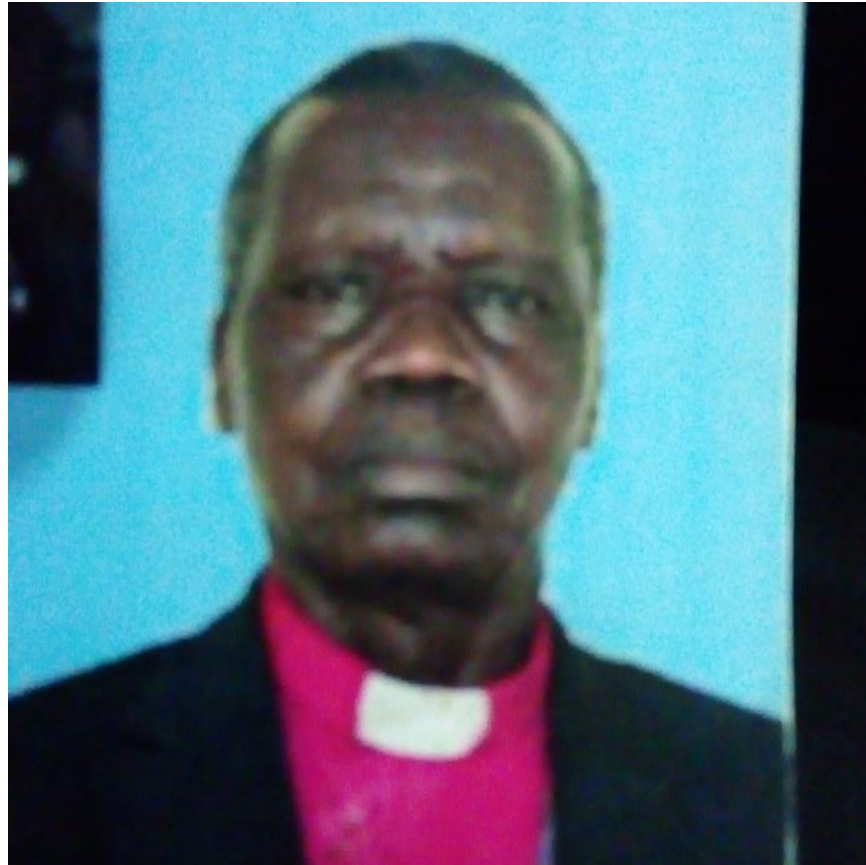
- 39 years later, Yei was inaugurated as a Diocese in August, 1984.

- Repatriation of BATC from Arua, Uganda to Yei, South Sudan.

- Cultivate 388 acres of coffee by 2032



for all mankind.**




4. Go forth and tell!
