#### Bible Reading for Today – Luke 17:5-10

<sup>5</sup> The apostles said to the Lord, 'Increase our faith!'

<sup>6</sup> He replied, 'If you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mulberry tree, "Be uprooted and planted in the sea," and it will obey you.

<sup>7</sup> 'Suppose one of you has a servant ploughing or looking after the sheep. Will he say to the servant when he comes in from the field, "Come along now and sit down to eat"? <sup>8</sup> Won't he rather say, "Prepare my supper, get yourself ready and wait on me while I eat and drink; after that you may eat and drink"? <sup>9</sup> Will he thank the servant because he did what he was told to do? <sup>10</sup> So you also, when you have done everything you were told to do, should say, "We are unworthy servants; we have only done our duty."
