## Bible Reading for Today – Mark 11: 1-10

<sup>1</sup>As they approached Jerusalem and came to Bethphage and Bethany at the Mount of Olives, Jesus sent two of his disciples, <sup>2</sup> saying to them, 'Go to the village ahead of you, and just as you enter it, you will find a colt tied there, which no one has ever ridden. Untie it and bring it here. <sup>3</sup> If anyone asks you, "Why are you doing this?" say, "The Lord needs it and will send it back here shortly."'

<sup>4</sup>They went and found a colt outside in the street, tied at a doorway. As they untied it, <sup>5</sup> some people standing there asked, 'What are you doing, untying that colt?' <sup>6</sup>They answered as Jesus had told them to, and the people let them go. <sup>7</sup>When they brought the colt to Jesus and threw their cloaks over it, he sat on it. <sup>8</sup>Many people spread their cloaks on the road, while others spread branches they had cut in the fields. <sup>9</sup>Those who went ahead and those who followed shouted, 'Hosanna!'

'Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!'

<sup>10</sup> 'Blessed is the coming kingdom of our father David!' 'Hosanna in the highest heaven!'
