# Donegal, Killymard, Lough Eske and Laghey 28<sup>th</sup> July 2024 – the Ninth Sunday after Trinity

### Bible Reading for Today – John 6: 5-11

<sup>5</sup>When Jesus looked up and saw a great crowd coming towards him, he said to Philip, 'Where shall we buy bread for these people to eat?' <sup>6</sup>He asked this only to test him, for he already had in mind what he was going to do. <sup>7</sup>Philip answered him, 'It would take more than half a year's wages to buy enough bread for each one to have a bite!' <sup>8</sup>Another of his disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, spoke up, <sup>9</sup> 'Here is a boy with five small barley loaves and two small fish, but how far will they go among so many?'

<sup>10</sup> Jesus said, 'Make the people sit down.' There was plenty of grass in that place, and they sat down (about five thousand men were there). <sup>11</sup> Jesus then took the loaves, gave thanks, and distributed to those who were seated as much as they wanted. He did the same with the fish.
