# Donegal, Killymard, Lough Eske and Laghey 1st September 2024 – Fourteenth Sunday after Trinity

#### Bible Reading for Today - Mark 7: 1-8

<sup>1</sup>The Pharisees and some of the teachers of the law who had come from Jerusalem gathered round Jesus <sup>2</sup> and saw some of his disciples eating food with hands that were defiled, that is, unwashed. <sup>3</sup> (The Pharisees and all the Jews do not eat unless they give their hands a ceremonial washing, holding to the tradition of the elders. <sup>4</sup> When they come from the market-place they do not eat unless they wash. And they observe many other traditions, such as the washing of cups, pitchers and kettles.) <sup>5</sup> So the Pharisees and teachers of the law asked Jesus, 'Why don't your disciples live according to the tradition of the elders instead of eating their food with defiled hands?'

<sup>6</sup>He replied, 'Isaiah was right when he prophesied about you hypocrites; as it is written: '"These people honour me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me. <sup>7</sup>They worship me in vain; their teachings are merely human rules." <sup>8</sup>You have let go of the commands of God and are holding on to human traditions.'
